When to Keep Your Child Home

- Fever 100°F or higher
- Vomiting 2+ times in 24 hours
- Diarrhea: 2+ loose stools
- Persistent cough or breathing difficulty
- Runny nose (not clear)
- Eye redness or discharge
- Contagious rashes or skin conditions
- Head lice (until treated)
- Severe fatigue or inability to participate
- Any diagnosed contagious illness



Return-to-School Guidelines

- Symptom-free for at least 24 hours
- No fever-reducing medication
- Energy back to normal
- Cleared or treated if contagious



If Your Child Gets Sick at School

- Parents contacted immediately
- Prompt pickup is required
- Child cared for until pickup



Health & Safety at Nihao

- Daily wellness checks
- Clean and sanitized environment
- Handwashing routines
- Following local health guidelines
- Up-to-date immunizations required



Family Partnership

- Monitor your child daily
- Keep child home when unsure
- Communicate with the school
- Help protect the community
